

wine Blickenweg 1/3 Pinot blanc, 1/3 Chardonnay, 1/3 grape variety Riesling vintage 2011 quality level quality wine country of origin Austria wine growing region Lower Austria wine growing area Kamptal Blickenweg vineyard soil Loess 1982, 1990 and 1977 planting of the vines plantation density 2900 vines/hectare = 1200/acre harvesting September 2011 vinification pressed with a pneumatic press, temperature-controlled fermentation (17 degrees Celsius) 18º KMW maturing must reading January 2011 alcohol in % vol 11,5 acidity in g/l 6,8 residual sugar in g/l 1,0 serve at 12 degrees Celsius

About the vineyard: This vineyard is probably one of the oldest locations in our community, mentioned as far back as 1083 in a letter of the Göttweig foundation. The soil is sandy loess with quartz, limestone, mica and clay particles. This vineyard forms a basin, which is shielded from cold winds by a wood. Emerging mist creates miscellaneous and interesting aromas in the grapes.
