

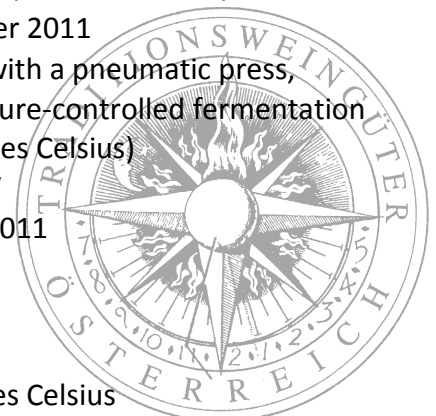


# BLICKENWEG

Riesling, Weißburgunder, Chardonnay › 1 vineyard, 3 grape varieties, 1 wine! He shows zest for life, coupled with ease. Drupes, full-bodied on the palate.

About the vineyard: This vineyard is probably one of the oldest locations in our community, mentioned as far back as 1083 in a letter of the Göttweig foundation. The soil is sandy loess with quartz, limestone, mica and clay particles. This vineyard forms a basin, which is shielded from cold winds by a wood. Emerging mist creates miscellaneous and interesting aromas in the grapes.
